<p><u>Outstanding (6)</u></p> <p>Exceeds all expectations of grade-level specific Speaking and Listening Standards</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Consistently listens without interrupting the speaker• Consistently follows multi-step oral directions• Demonstrates understanding by paraphrasing or restating• Speaks in complete sentences and shows vocabulary development in everyday speech• Consistently expresses ideas clearly and logically
<p><u>Very Good (5)</u></p> <p>Exceeds most expectations of grade-level specific Speaking and Listening Standards</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Listens without interrupting the speaker most of the time• Follows multi-step oral directions most of the time• Responds to speaker with remarks that relate to topic• Speaks in complete sentences and uses some newly acquired vocabulary in everyday speech• Expresses most ideas clearly and logically
<p><u>Good (4)</u></p> <p>Meets most expectations of grade-level specific Speaking and Listening Standards</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Listens with few interruptions• Follows multi-step oral directions some of the time and single step directions most of the time.• Usually responds with remarks relating to topic• Speaks in sentences with increased level of vocabulary• Attempts to express ideas with clarity and logic
<p><u>Satisfactory (3)</u></p> <p>Has met some and continues to work at meeting expectations of grade-level Speaking and Listening Standards</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Listens without interrupting some of the time• Follows one-step oral directions• Usually appears to comprehend• Speaks in simple sentences• Is beginning to express ideas clearly

Unsatisfactory (1)

Unacceptable progress in meeting the expectations of grade-level Speaking and Listening Standards

- Makes **little or no attempt** to listen in group settings and distracts others
- Does not follow oral directions
- Does not contribute to conversations or discussions
- Difficult to understand when speaking
